All participants of PoGO TXK are expected to abide by our Code of Conduct, both online and during in-person events that are hosted and/or associated with PoGo TXK

The Pledge

In the interest of fostering an open and welcoming environment, we pledge to make participation in our project and our community a harassment-free experience for everyone.

The Standards

Examples of behavior that contributes to creating a positive environment include:

- Using welcoming and inclusive language
- Being respectful of differing viewpoints and experiences
- Gracefully accepting constructive criticism

Examples of unacceptable behavior by participants include:

- Trolling, insulting/derogatory comments, public or private harassment
- Publishing others' private information, such as a physical or electronic address, without explicit permission
- Not being respectful to reasonable communication boundaries, such as 'leave me alone,' 'go away,' or 'I'm not discussing this with you.'
- The usage of sexualised language or imagery and unwelcome sexual attention or advances

- Demonstrating the graphics or any other content you know may be considered disturbing
- Starting and/or participating in arguments related to politics Attacking personal tastes Other conduct which you know could reasonably be considered inappropriate in a professional setting.

Make an official report by messaging “Yanja” on Campfire. All reports will be reviewed and investigated and will result in a response that is deemed necessary and appropriate to the circumstances. Further details of specific enforcement policies may be posted separately. We hold the right and responsibility to remove comments or other contributions that are not aligned to this Code of Conduct, or to ban temporarily or permanently any members for other behaviors that they deem inappropriate, threatening, offensive, or harmful. Any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this contract, or the breach, termination or invalidity thereof, shall be settled by arbitration.
